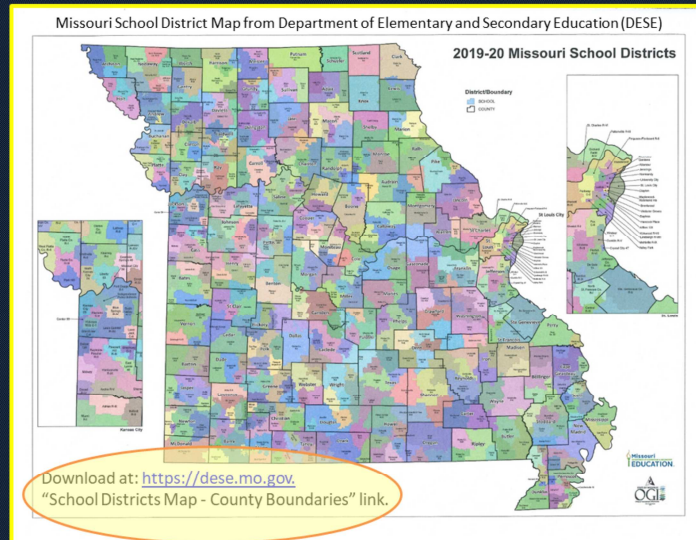


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Slide 1 Average School Tax Rate

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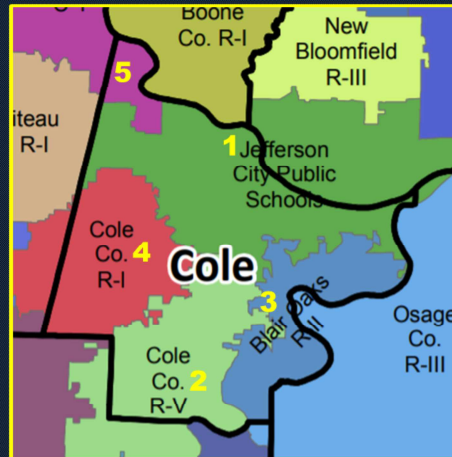
Slide 2 Missouri School Districts Map

The Average School Tax Rate is applied by the County Clerks to the distributable assessed value of Centrally Assessed Companies. The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) provides a map of all Missouri school districts. The map may be downloaded from DESE's website at:

Select the "School Districts Map - County Boundaries" link to see the color coded boundaries of each Missouri school district. School district boundaries may extend into adjacent counties.

Cole County School Districts



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Slide 3 Cole County School Districts

Five school districts are shown in the displayed map of Cole County. The tax levies for all five school districts are included in the calculation of the average school tax rate for Cole County. The taxes paid to a county on distributable assessed value are apportioned to the school districts in the county, based on each school's September Membership reported to DESE.

Average School Tax Rate

The County Clerk's Average School Tax Rate is used for:

1. Calculating the tax liability on distributable assessed value
2. The tax levy setting process with the Missouri State Auditor's Office (SAO)
3. The State Assessed Railroad & Utilities (SARRU) financial data planning with DESE
 - SARRU = Centrally Assessed Railroad and Utility Companies (CARUC) **PLUS** Commercial Aircraft Owned by Airlines (CAOBA)



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Slide 4 Average School Tax Rate

The County Clerk's Average School Tax Rate is used for:

1. Calculating the tax liability on distributable assessed value.
2. The tax levy setting process with the Missouri State Auditor's Office (SAO).
3. The State Assessed Railroad & Utilities (SARRU) financial data planning with DESE.

SARRU =
Centrally Assessed Railroad and Utility Companies (CARUC)
PLUS
Commercial Aircraft Owned by Airlines (CAOBA)

The average school tax rate is always used for the State Assessed Railroad & Utilities (SARRU) tax liability calculation.

Locally Assessed Railroad and Utility property, Commercial Aircraft Owned By Others (CAOBO), and Private Cars do not use the average school tax rate in their tax liability calculation.
